In 2008, Wings to Fly will expand its presence to include additional camps in Colorado and is branching out into Arizona. "Due to numerous requests, we will also increase our enrollment age, and in 2008 will serve two age groups: ages 10-11 and ages 12-13," Kris Franklin, Executive Director of Wings to Fly, confirmed. This year's camp impacted seven girls from all over Colorado and one girl from Ohio. By participating in fun and exciting activities, the girls all left the camp with a better understanding of who they are as young women in today's society.

Wings to Fly's intensive educational camp integrates inspiration, knowledge, research-proven resources and coaching into the girls' daily activities, enabling the development of essential qualities needed to become the leaders of tomorrow. The camp also promotes mandatory parent or primary caregiver participation, a unique feature of the program that enables growth to continue in the girls' daily life.

"The follow-up telephone coaching sessions with parents and primary caregivers who have seen remarkable changes in their daughters have been so rewarding," said Renie Cavallari, founder and lead coach at the August camp. "For these girls, their options for the future are abundant and they now truly have wings to fly."
